This unit will last approximately 7-10 days and will cover the following topics from the Choosing the Best Path and Glencoe Curriculum: 1) Developing the Best Relationships; 2) Avoiding STDs and HIV/AIDS; 3) Preventing Teen Pregnancy; 4) Dealing with Pressure; 5) Choosing the Best Path; 6)Setting Boundaries; 7) Speaking Up; 8) Being Assertive; 9) Review of male and female anatomy and changes that occur during puberty.

During this unit only Cobb County School District approved materials will be used. These materials may be viewed by contacting your child's health teacher. This program will help students avoid risky situations, make positive choices, ward off sexual advances and understand the benefits of remaining abstinent until marriage.

We believe that parents and guardians are the primary resource for students in this area. We want to work with you in providing information on these vital subjects. Research shows that students do listen to parents in this most important area of their life.
